WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Apache County School District No. 3 has requested the Tribe to gratuitously surrender all of its right, title and interest in and to the Maverick School Building, and


WHEREAS, stipulation No. 18 of the lease between the Tribe and the said School District provides that the buildings shall revert to the Tribe upon the succession of the District using the said school building, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council and/or the Bureau of Indian Affairs have no legal authority to give away tribal property.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council reluctantly refuses to surrender the said Maverick School Building to the Eagar Apache County School District No. 3.

The foregoing resolution was on May 1, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
