FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Doctor Robert H. Jochim has made many notable improvements in the Indian Health Program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, he has shown a deep personal interest in the welfare of the Indian people and generously contributed his own time and talents to assist Tribal members in all walks of life, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to express its appreciation to Doctor Jochim and encourage him to remain on the reservation as long as possible.

BE IT RESOLVED that Doctor Robert H. Jochim is herewith made an Honorary Member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with full hunting and fishing privileges. This Honorary Membership and these privileges shall be valid as long as Doctor Jochim remains as a resident of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 1, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
