


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has increased the salary of Steven Lupe, Livestock Inspector, \$14.00 per month provided the Tribe matches said increase, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that Steven Lupe is worthy of an increase in salary.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated, and the Tribal Budget is hereby amended to provide for, the sum of \$288.00 to cover the increased cost of providing for a salary increase of \$14.00 per month, plus all payroll taxes and insurance to defray the cost of a \$14.00 a month salary increase of Steven Lupe, Tribal Livestock Inspector.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
