

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Commissioner Bennet has proposed and recommended that the White Mountain Apache Tribe become a member of the American Indian Athletic Hall of Fame, and

WHEREAS, the said Commissioner has forwarded a proposed Constitution and By-Laws together with suggested members of its first Board of Trustees to represent the Indian and Alaska Native peoples in establishing the Hall of Fame and selecting those who will be in it, and

WHEREAS, the adopted members are outstanding Indian leaders and the Constitution and By-Laws are well drafted, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to participate in and become a member of the said Athletic Hall of Fame Organization.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe hereby approves the initial board members as recommended by Commissioner Bennett and further approve the Constitution and By-Laws of the American Indian Athletic Hall of Fame as submitted by the Commissioner.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to sign any and all necessary documents to enroll the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the said organization to be known as the American Indian Athletic Hall of Fame.

The foregoing resolution was on June 26, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
