

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Chairman, at the last meeting appointed a Forestry Committee to study the new plan of operations of the tribal forest, and

WHEREAS, among other things, the plan of operations provide for the implication of the Tribal Sawmill Block, and

WHEREAS, the Forestry Committee has met and made the following recommendations to-wit:

1. That a continuing supply of timber and other forest resource requirements for Fort Apache Timber Company and for the Cibecue Forest Industry be issued.
2. That Fort Apache Timber Company's Plan of Operation be modified to include the North Fork and Maverick Blocks provided that the volume and species permitted to be cut from these blocks will be restricted to the allowable annual cut as prescribed in the Forest Management Plan.
3. That the Southwest and Northwest Blocks be reserved for the Cibecue Timber Industry.
4. That the basic concept will be multiple purpose for maximum tribal benefits and the Forestry Committee shall designate the location and the standards of the main roads to be constructed and after the Forestry Committee has approved the total engineering and estimated construction cost of the said roads, they will be presented to the Council for its review and approval before construction is commenced.


BE IT RESOLVED that the above recommendations in total are hereby approved by the Tribal Council.


The foregoing resolution was on June 26, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
