

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a permit was issued in 1967 to W. L. Minckley, Ph. D., Associate Professor, Zoology, Arizona State University to conduct studies of the vertebra animals on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, conditions of the permit required that a series of specimens and full reports of all activities would be provided to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and


WHEREAS, all conditions of the permit were met and the Tribe gained valuable information from the studies, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Minckley has requested permission for a continuation of the studies on an annual basis.

BE IT RESOLVED that said request be approved subject to an annual review and acceptance by the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise and its game management section.

The foregoing resolution was on June 26, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
