

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to conserve and maintain its wildlife resources for the benefit of all tribal members and the public at large and harvest the resources in accordance with sound game management practices, and

WHEREAS, surveys show that a huntable population of game animals, surplus to the needs of the tribe exist on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the sale of hunting permits to non-members provides an important source of revenue for game management and game enforcement purposes, and

WHEREAS, the responsibility for fish and game enforcement on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is vested in the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors has made recommendations to the Tribal Council for the 1968-69 non-member game regulations, season dates, bag limits and permit fees.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached non-member game regulations, season dates, bag limits and permit fees be approved by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 26, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
