


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, U. S. Department of Interior Fish and Wildlife Service, Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife, Whiteriver, Arizona has requested that the Tribe donate to it, 1,000 yards of cinders from the Cooley Mountain Truck Pit, said cinders to be used on the access road leading to and on the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery grounds, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe receives great benefit from the operation of the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and/or the Superintendent are hereby authorized to issue a gratuitous permit for 1,000 yards of cinders to the Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife, said cinders to be used on the access road and the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery grounds.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
