


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the San Carlos Job Corps has done extensive improvements on the San Carlos Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires said Job Corps Members to improve the Kinishba Ruins and other projects.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Area Director is hereby requested to delegate as many of the San Carlos Job Corps Members to work on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation during the summer of 1969, said Job Corps Members to be housed and fed at the Theodore Roosevelt School, Fort Apache, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
