


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Office have certain business machines which do not operate efficiently, and

WHEREAS, to replace these machines, it would cost approximately, One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury Department, the sum of One Thousand Dollars (1,000.00) to purchase three business machines, the type and make to be determined by the Tribal Administrative Officer.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
