

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Grasshopper Logging Unit is included in the five year Timber Sale Program, and

WHEREAS, timber from this unit is part of the allowable cut.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Grasshopper Logging Unit as presented in the Forest Officer's Report and proposed contract covering the recommended sale of this timber and subject to minor changes and administrative adjustments by the Approving Officer be advertised for sale by sealed bid followed by oral auction at the following minimum rate per thousand board feet:

plus \$1.52 per thousand B.F. for road deposit which is reimbursed to the purchaser as sections of the Class IV Road are approved by the Superintendent.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a deduction of 50% of the value of the timber cut and scaled shall be made until such time as a total value of \$67,704.00 has been accrued. This money if not reimbursed to the purchaser as stated above shall be used to construct a Class IV Road as stated in the Proposed Grasshopper Forest Officer's Report and Contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the purchaser be required to establish a band mill in the immediate vicinity of Cibecue, Arizona, site and plans of which will require Bureau approval. All timber from this unit must be manufactured to a rough green status at this installation unless relief is granted by the Area Director and the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to execute the contract and related documents necessary to administer the sale of the timber for and on behalf of this Council.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
