WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that a Sunrise Park Committee should be appointed to investigate, coordinate and assist in consummating the constructing for and building of the Sunrise Project.

BE IT RESOLVED that Arch Penrod, Chairman, Barry DeRose, Robert E. Robinson, Don Pogue, Joe Dora, Ford Benham, Nelson Lupe, Sr. and William Glidden, alternate, are hereby appointed as members of the Sunrise Park Committee with authority to travel to different Ski Run Projects to secure drawings, maps and any other documents appertaining to ski runs and lake developments and to recommend to the Tribal Council and Chairman a feasible ski run, lake development complex.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal Funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury, the sum of \$2500.00 to pay the expenses and per diem of the Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
