

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, all of the present funded Community Action Programs are beneficial to the White Mountain Apache Tribe and have great merit, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires that these programs be continued and refunded.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Director of the Community Action Program of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is hereby authorized and director to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the refunding of all Community Action Programs now being operated on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized to sign any and all application forms to renew the projects.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
