

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 68-84 passed July 12, 1968, converted the stumpage payments for the Fort Apache Timber Company to a ratio system, and


WHEREAS, as of September 1, 1968, when the new system went into effect there was an inventory of lumber which the Fort Apache Timber Company had paid for under the old system.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Fort Apache Timber Company will be reimbursed for this inventory based on the average monthly value per thousand board feet, F.O.B. mill, on the following schedule:

September	1,510,875 bd. ft.
October	1,600,000 bd. ft.
November	1,600,000 bd. ft.
December	<u>1,600,000</u> bd. ft.
	6,310,875 bd. ft.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Branch of Forestry is authorized to make this deduction from Fort Apache Timber Company's monthly stumpage payments as determined by the ratio system.

The foregoing resolution was on September 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 stat. 984).
