

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Charles and Mildred Montgomery now have a lease with the Tribe of the premises whereon the Whiteriver Econo-Wash is located, and

WHEREAS, the lease has approximately twenty-one years to run, and


WHEREAS, the said Charles and Mildred Montgomery desire to sell said business and assign said lease to Michael and Marcia Peddie.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute a consent to assignment of the said lease between the Tribe and Michael and Marcia Peddie, and to also consent to the mortgaging of the premises to secure the payment of same by Michael and Marcia Peddie.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Michael and Marcia Peddie are hereby approved for a Tribal Trader's License and a Federal Indian Trader's License for the operation of the Whiteriver Econo-Wash.

The foregoing resolution was on September 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
