


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it was necessary to secure a topographic survey of the Sunrise complex in order to sensibly interest engineering firms in bidding on the architectural and engineering costs of the construction of the complex.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal funds a sum not to exceed \$1200.00 to defray the cost of the topographic survey of the Sunrise complex.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Sunrise Committee is hereby authorized to approve the payment to the engineering firm that conducts the survey.

The foregoing resolution was on September 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
