

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has approved the establishment of a committee consisting of George Heddon, Jim Chamberlain, and William S. Glidden to confer with a similarly constituted committee of the Salt River Project officials, subsequently named as Victor I. Corbell, President of the Salt River Valley Water Users' Association, R. J. McMullin, General Manager and Henry Shipley, Assistant General Manager, and
- WHEREAS, the two negotiating committees met a total of seven times during the summer of 1968; on June 11 and 27; July 15 and 31; August 22 and 30; September 6, and
- WHEREAS, the negotiating groups came to an agreement pending ratification by the Tribal Council on a water allotment for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation which also contains an understanding of use and an agreed depletion rate for each use, and
- WHEREAS, on this date the Tribal Council has been given a detailed and thorough explanation of said agreement.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council approves the said Memorandum of Agreement of September 6, 1968 with the Salt River Valley Water Users' Association on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 16, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against and 1 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
