WHEREAS, Joe Dora has for years served on enterprise boards of the White Mountain Apache Tribe without compensation, and

WHEREAS, Joe Dora has the interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe at heart, and


WHEREAS, said Joe Dora sacrifices his own time and money for the White Mountain Apache people, and

WHEREAS, said Joe Dora is always an advocate for the White Mountain Apaches in many of its controvercies.

BE IT RESOLVED that Joe Dora is hereby made an honorary member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Joe Dora is hereby granted gratuituous tribal hunting and fishing privileges on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on September 16, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 4 for, 3 against, 1 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
