

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 68-45 authorized the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council to sign a twenty-five (25) year gratuitous lease with a twenty-five (25) year option, covering approximately fifteen acres, with the Alchesay High School District No. 20, for the establishment of a Junior High School, additional housing for teachers, and an additional area for garages, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested to revise said resolution to read "Board of Trustees, Elementary District No. 20", and


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, Elementary District No. 20 has now furnished a legal description and topographical map of the area they desire to lease, which is on file with the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is hereby authorized for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to sign a twenty-five (25) year gratuitous lease together with a twenty-five (25) year option covering 11.70 acres of ground adjacent to the present school premises with the Board of Trustees, Elementary District No. 20.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 68-45 adopted on May 1, 1968 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on September 30, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
