

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development, through its Neighborhood Facilities Program, has funded a Neighborhood Facility for the community of Whiteriver on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, Resolution No. 68-35 of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council budgeted \$62,500.00 as the Tribe's share of the construction cost, and

WHEREAS, HUD approved a grant in the amount of \$187,665.00, and

WHEREAS, the Department of HUD did not approve certain items for completion of the project which are needed to make the facility complete and useful to the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 is hereby appropriated from funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United States for the purchase and installation of those items listed on the attachment and made a part hereof.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


