

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has centralized all of its accounting in the Tribal Business Office with the exception of Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, to make sound businesslike decisions, it is necessary for the Council to have current information in regards to the accounting of the Business Office, and

WHEREAS, Profit & Loss Statements have not been made available to the Council on each of the Tribal Business Enterprises on a current basis, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has not been kept current on income and expenditures of the Tribal Budget.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Administrative Manager is hereby directed to provide Profit and Loss Statements prior to the 15th day of each month to members of the Tribal Council on all enterprises along with the expenditures of tribal funds and income received for the prior month.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Manager of the Fort Apache Timber Company is hereby directed to provide members of the Tribal Council with the Profit and Loss Statements by the 15th of the month for the prior month.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
