FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Save the Children Federation Program has been active on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation since 1966, and


WHEREAS, 701 children are now sponsored by the Save the Children Federation Program, and

WHEREAS, a special grant has been received by the various communities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for home improvement.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that not to exceed \$3,000.00 is hereby appropriated from funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United States to match a special grant from Save the Children Federation for home improvement in various communities.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
