

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Save the Children Federation Program has received grants to communities in the amount of \$31,584.00 plus amount received from sponsors for children in the amount of \$78,960.00 plus an amount of \$21,065.00 received in special grants for community improvement, and

WHEREAS, the Public Health Service has agreed to provide a truck and all vehicle expenses provided the Tribal Council will hire a driver for community improvements, garbage disposal, etc.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the amount not to exceed \$3,584.00 is hereby appropriated from funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United States for the employment of a truck driver for community improvement purposes which will be at the rate of \$2.00 per hour plus employees benefits contributions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the effective date of this employment will be the date of the approval of the Area Director of the budget amendment.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
