

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Kay Anthony Lewis and Bowman Daley, both known to be full blood San Carlos Apache Indians appeared before the Tribal Council requesting that they be granted membership in the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Bowman Daley being an enrolled member of the San Carlos Apache Tribe has agreed to relinquish membership and the Tribal Council of the San Carlos Apache Tribe have agreed to grant this relinquishment upon receiving membership in the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bowman Daley has resided on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation approximately ten years and married to a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with one child, and

WHEREAS, Kay Anthony Lewis, although not an enrolled member of the San Carlos Apache Tribe, is full blood Apache Indian having been born in Cibecue, Arizona on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation. His parents being known to living members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Kay Anthony Lewis is now serving as the Chief Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court, and

WHEREAS, both Mr. Bowman Daley and Kay Anthony Lewis are of good character and outstanding citizens of the communities.

BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Bowman Daley and Kay Anthony Lewis are hereby adopted to full membership in the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Secretary of the Tribal Council is hereby directed to enter them on the roll of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Bowman Daley and Kay Anthony Lewis are hereby granted all privileges of membership and those that may accrue hereafter to any other member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 2 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
