

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received a grant in the amount of \$232,000.00 and a loan in the amount of \$58,000.00 from the Economic Development Administration to construct a vocational skill training school, EDA Project No. 08-1-00604, and


WHEREAS, the site selected for the vocational training school is included in the area now under permit to the Alchesay High School District No. 20.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Board of Trustees of Alchesay High School District No. 20 are hereby requested to release the following described lands in order that construction of the vocational training school may begin as soon as possible:

Beginning at the south, southeast corner of the fenced area for the present High School, located in NE/4 of Section 13; T5N; R22E; thence N.23°45'E., a distance of 195.0 feet; thence N.66°15'W., a distance of 320.0 feet; thence S.23°45'W., a distance of 195.0 feet; thence S66°15'E., a distance of 320.0 feet back to the point of beginning. Said area contains 62,400 square feet or 1.433 acres, more or less.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when the above-described area is released by the Alchesay High School District No. 20, the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, are hereby authorized and directed to execute an amendment to the Permit now in effect.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
