

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Paul E. Amos, Jr. has resigned from the position as Manager of the Tribal Maintenance Department to assume the position of General Livestock Manager, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Julius Armstrong, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is a long time employee of this Department, being a Journeyman carpenter, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Julius Armstrong has always performed as a faithful and efficient employee of this Department.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Julius Armstrong is hereby appointed as Manager of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Maintenance Department, effective October 29, 1968, which is the date of his Temporary Appointment by the Tribal Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
