



RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received approval from EDA for construction of the Sunrise Recreation Complex along with a grant in the amount of \$1,588,000.00, and
- WHEREAS, Larry H. Bell and Associates had previously carried out a Feasibility Study for the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the Mount Ord Ski Run which is a part of the Sunrise Recreation Complex, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe renders Larry H. Bell and Associates to prepare the original application to EDA for the Recreation Complex, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, upon the recommendations of the Sunrise Committee, appointed by the Tribal Council, feels that it is to the benefit of the Tribe to hire the firm of Haver Nunn & Jenson as Architects and Engineers to complete the project.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and the Sunrise Committee are hereby directed to negotiate payment to Larry H. Bell and Associates to those services rendered to date.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
