


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company is in need of the Lane Deer Logging Unit for their winters logging because of a reversal in their logging plans created by Mr. Albert Wahl, and

WHEREAS, the contract and appraisal are not yet complete.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Forestry Committee review the contract and other pertinent papers and the Tribal Chairman approve the Lane Deer Logging Unit contract on the Forestry Committee's recommendations.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
