

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, most of the families of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are still living in inadequate housing, and

WHEREAS, many members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are now ineligible for participation in the Mutual Aid Housing program due to the fact that their income exceeds present income limits, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to create opportunity for securing adequate housing for its members, and


WHEREAS, the Council has noted the economic and social impact and influence on those families that have heretofore built homes through the mutual aid program, and


WHEREAS, other sources of finance for homes is almost nil.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the following schedule of annual income limits be approved subject to approval of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Housing Authority and the Department of HUD, HAA as follows:

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
