

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe's Architect/Engineer for the Sunrise Project has recommended that the Tribe conduct soil test at the project site, and

WHEREAS, it is a Phoenix Contractual who is conducting soil test in close proximity to the Sunrise Project, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe could have the test conducted at a much cheaper rate if done now, and

WHEREAS, if the soil test are not made immediately, it could add an additional five months on the completion date of the Sunrise Project.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasurer the sum of \$1150.00 to defer the cost of conducting soil test at the Sunrise Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Triba, at the appropriate time, request repayment of this sum from the Federal Government.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
