

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a great increase in use of both commercial and private air transportation in the White Mountain area, and

WHEREAS, there is no adequate airport in the White Mountain to serve present as well as increasing needs, and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has plans and definite project for expansion of the lumber and related industries and other enterprises related to tourism such as the Sunrise Recreation Complex, and


WHEREAS, an airstrip located near the Hondah Homesite would increase income and job opportunity by increased business at Hondah Motel and restaurant, Indian Pine, McNary, Hondah Homesites, Pinetop Country Club, White Mountain Country Club and Pinetop-Lakeside business community, Hawley Lake and Sunrise Recreation Complex.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized and directed to make application through EDA for construction of an airstrip at Hondah.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that adequate land and access is hereby reserved for construction of the Hondah Airport.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
