FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the general public relations funds is practically depleted, and

WHEREAS, the Chairman has used the said funds to the greater advantage
of the White Mountain Apaches, and

WHEREAS, there are many future programs in which additional public relation
funds will be needed.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on
deposit with the U. S. Treasury the additional sum of \$2500.00
for the General Public Relations Account.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote
of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain
Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1
(k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the
Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29,
1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
