FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Chairman advised the Council that there was a definite need for a Coordinator in expediting the many Federal Programs that have been applied for by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for one person to be responsible for making applications for additional funds from many available Federal Programs.


BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$5,000.00 is hereby budgeted to defray the cost of the salary and travel expenses to employ a Coordinator for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to select the said Coordinator.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said sum of \$5,000.00 is to be obtained from savings within the budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is to seek the advice and guidance of Don Pogue, Robert E. Robinson and Barry DeRose in determining the choice and need of the new Coordinator.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
