

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Christmas Tree Lake has been constructed by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, this lake has been designated as an Apache Trout preservation and propagation project, and


WHEREAS, a population of Apache golden trout has been established in the lake by the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise and the Bureau of Sports Fisheries and Wildlife, and


WHEREAS, a short open fishing season for Christmas Tree Lake has been recommended for 1969.

BE IT RESOLVED that Christmas Tree Lake be opened to fishing from September 1, 1969 to and including September 14, 1969.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that creel limits and other necessary regulations be established by the Tribal Game Department and the Fisheries Biologist.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
