FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Farm Improvement Association (Farm Coop.) receives budgeted funds from the Tribal Treasury, and


WHEREAS, the Farm Coop. does not have adequate equipment to transport farm tractors and other equipment from one location to another, and

WHEREAS, there are no funds budgeted for capital improvements or equipment purchase but there are available funds in Account 01-18-7420, Machinery Operating Expense to cover the purchase of a pickup truck.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council approves the expenditure of not to exceed \$2600.00 for the purchase of a pickup truck out of Account 01-18-7420.

The foregoing resolution was on March 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
