

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, certain of the Game Wardens attend the Annual Boat Show held in Los Angeles, California every year, and

WHEREAS, during their stay, the Game Wardens establish a Public Relations Booth and distribute literatures regarding the White Mountain Apache Recreational potential, and

WHEREAS, the Recreation and Apache Enterprises reap great profits from this type of advertisement and public relations, and

WHEREAS, the hotel and food accommodations in the Los Angeles area are very expensive.

BE IT RESOLVED that during that period of time, that the Game Wardens are attending the annual boat show in Los Angeles, California, that they be allowed \$25.00 per diem.

The foregoing resolution was on March 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
