

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity Program expected to receive an allocation of funds sometime ago, and


WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has appropriated funds for the Office of Economic Opportunity subsequently approved by the President of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity will have to cease operation if it is not financed funds by the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$50,000.00 on deposit in the Treasury of the United States to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be hereby appropriated for advancement to the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that immediately upon receipt of Office of Economic Opportunity funds, the total amount will be repaid and deposited to the General Account of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
