


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the U. S. Public Health Service Division of Indian Health has for the past several years assisted the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the construction and operations of domestic water systems in the various communities on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe would like to expedite the construction of Public Law 86-121 Water Systems on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of \$750.00 which includes all fringe benefits from savings to be made within the FY 68-69 Tribal Budget to pay for labor of four (4) men to work on 86-121 Domestic Water Projects.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
