FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Navopache Electric Coop., Inc., serves the major portion of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, Navopache Electric Coop., Inc. has requested permission to install a 960 MHZ direct line of sight radio on Cinder Mountain near McNary to better improve their services to the reservation and adjoining areas.


BE IT RESOLVED that Navopache Electric Coop., Inc. be granted permission to install the radio system as requested.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a proper discription of the area needed be submitted and the Chairman of the Tribal Council is directed and authorized to sign all necessary documents.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
