

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the anticipated income of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1969 and ending April 30, 1970 will be \$1,229,157 and


WHEREAS, in order to provide funds for the continuation of certain Tribal activities, for education and welfare purposes for members of the Tribe and for the development, protection and conservation fo Reser-
vation resources and for other purposes during the 1969-70 fiscal year, such activities will cost \$1,126,133.

BE IT RESOLVED that it is hereby authorized and appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States the sum of \$1,126,133.00. The funds are to be expended in accordance with the items listed in the budget attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Treasurer shall make disbursements of Tribal funds appropriated herein and only upon signatures authorized by the properly designated Tribal employees and approved by the Chair-
man and the Administrative Manager.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all remaining unobligated balances as of April 30, 1969 are hereby cancelled and such unobligated balances shall be re-
turned to the general account of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on April 15, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 26, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
