


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is a member, in good standing, of the Indian Development District of Arizona, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that it is to the benefit of both the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the San Carlos Apache Tribe to set up independent districts.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby directed to make application to the proper officials to designate the Fort Apache Indian Reservation ~~as one planning district~~ and San Carlos Apache Indian Reservation as a separate planning district.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against and 1 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
