

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the tribe has been granted \$1,580,000.00 from EDA for the construction of Sunrise Recreation Complex, and
- WHEREAS, funds have not yet been advanced to the Tribe by EDA, and
- WHEREAS, certain topographic and engineering work is necessary to complete the final specifications and plans for the Sunrise Recreation Complex, and
- WHEREAS, Phase 2 of the Sunrise Project has been discussed with EDA which will provide a dining room, bar and facilities beyond Phase 1 making it necessary to hire an interior designer prior to approval of Phase 2.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the amount of \$1200.00 is hereby approved for expenditure from contingency funds previously approved by Tribal Resolution No. 69-52.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said sum of \$4,000.00 also approved to be expended from contingency funds previously approved by Tribal Resolution No. 69-52, Tribal Budget for Fiscal Year 1969-70 for contracting of an interior designer.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
