

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 68-143 authorized \$12,000.00 for the Road Suspense Account for improvement of the Upper Log Road, and


WHEREAS, this road has been improved for a total cost of \$14,713.76, the increased costs due to additional work being required which was not contemplated originally, and

WHEREAS, the original estimated cost of the Upper Log Road Bridge was \$13,300.00 and there was a savings of \$3,300.00 in constructing this bridge.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the additional work be authorized and that the Upper Log Road Suspense Account authorization be increased to \$14,713.76.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
