

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the number of students eligible to attend the Tribal Youth Camps and applications therefor have increased tremendously over the past year, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council that all eligible youngsters be given consideration for attendance in Tribal Youth Camps during the summer of 1969, and


WHEREAS, increasing the number of participants will necessitate the need of increasing that part of the Tribal Budget providing for salaries and taxes for greater participants (students), and

WHEREAS, the summer camp committee has advised that certain savings can be made within Section XII - Education Expense, B. Summer Camp Program to provide the extra salary and expense in the amount of \$6,000.00 and the additional needed in the amount of \$500.00 for laundry.

BE IT RESOLVED that Section XII - Education Expense, B. Summer Camp Program Accounts 28-7110 through 28-7440 be adjusted within the total accounts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the overall total of these accounts may not be exceeded.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
