WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair Commission has had an outstanding payment due to Grabe Lumber Company for one year, and


WHEREAS, certain persons charged building materials to the Fair Commission without proper authority, and


WHEREAS, this outstanding account tends to give the White Mountain Apache Tribe bad reputation in regards to payment of bills.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the amount of \$2,185.00 is hereby approved for payment from the Contingency Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Fair Commission along with the Tribal Administrative Manager will, in the future, approve all requisitions for purchases charged to the Fair Commission and be responsible for payment thereof from funds under their control.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
