

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Lame Deer Logging Unit Contract, No. H50C1420-6709, was approved by the Area Director, January 2, 1969 between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, a portion of the sale boundary borders against the Diamond Creek No. 3 Logging Unit which has expired. Adjacent to this boundary there is approximately two million board feet of timber that was not cut under the Diamond Creek No. 3 Contract and is in need of cutting, and

WHEREAS, this timber can be harvested and sold under the Lame Deer Contract and has been requested by the Fort Apache Timber Company.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Lame Deer Logging Unit Contract be modified to include this timber in need of cutting as determined by the Branch of Forestry. Further, that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is authorized to sign all documents pertinent to this modification.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that except as herein modified, the remainder of the Lame Deer Contract shall remain in full force and effect and binding upon the parties thereto as though no modification had been made.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
