

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has increased the salary for Steven Lupe, Livestock Inspector, in the amount of \$501.00 per annum retro-active this July 1, 1969, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has an agreement with the State Livestock Sanitation Board to provide half salary and expenses for a Livestock Inspector, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council considers Steven Lupe worthy of an increase in salary, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Budget for Fiscal Year 69-70 does not provide for this increase.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the amount of \$501.00 is hereby appropriated from the U. S. Treasury on deposit with the U. S. Treasurer for payment of this increase in salary matching state funds for salary, taxes and fringe benefits.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
