

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe now retains Olliver-Pilcher and Associates as its general agents for all types of insurance, and


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to obtain maximum insurance coverage at minimum cost, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Downey of Snodgrass-Lovitt and Downey, Inc. have submitted a proposal to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe which shows considerable savings according to Mr. Downey.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that effective upon the expiration of the present insurance policies with Olliver-Pilcher and Associates, the firm of Snodgrass-Lovitt and Downey, Inc. is to be appointed general insurance agents for the White Mountain Apache Tribe and its enterprises.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is to investigate boiler insurance at Fort Apache Timber Company and snow damage insurance for Hondah, Indian Pine, Hawley Lake and Horseshoe Lake.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
