

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Elementary District School No. 20 has three land leases in effect, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees and Superintendent of School District No. 20 have requested that these leases be consolidated into one lease.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Contract No. 14-20-OH52-40, a lease consisting of 2.08 acres; Contract No. 14-20-OH52-31, a lease consisting of .50 acres and Contract No. 14-20-OH52-49, a lease consisting of 7.42 acres be consolidated into a single lease by and between the Board of Trustees of School District No. 20, Navajo County, Arizona and the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Tribal Council are hereby authorized to execute said lease.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this lease will be for a period of twenty-five (25) years with a twenty-five (25) year option.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
