

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has applied for a loan for the improvement of the Whiteriver Trailer Park through the Revolving Credit Program with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, this project is considered of the highest priority due to present unsanitary conditions at Whiteriver Trailer Park, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that there is a possibility of obtaining a grant for improvement of the Whiteriver Trailer Park.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to apply for a grant of \$16,000.00 through the Bureau of Indian Affairs for improvement of the Whiteriver Trailer Park.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
